Cabinet approved signing of revised Air Services Agreement between India and Nigeria

The Union Cabinet has given its approval for signing of the revised Air Services Agreement (ASA) between India and Nigeria. The earlier Agreement was signed on 31st January, 1978. The updation of the Agreement is as per latest International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) template keeping in view of latest developments in civil aviation sector and with an objective to improve the air connectivity between the two countries.

The revised Agreement signifies an important landmark in the civil aviation relations between India and Nigeria and has the potential to spur greater trade, investment, tourism and cultural exchanges between the two countries.

The essential features of the Air Services Agreement are as follows:

- i) Both countries shall be entitled to designate one or more airlines.
- ii) The designated airlines of either country shall have the right to establish offices in the territory of the other country for the promotion and sale of air services.
- iii) Both sides agreed to operate any number of all Cargo services between each other's territory with any type of aircraft with full 3rd, 4th and 5th freedom traffic rights.
- iv) The designated airline will be free to decide tariffs in respect of the agreed services at reasonable levels based on the commercial considerations.
- v) The designated Airline of each party can enter into cooperative marketing arrangements with the designated carriers of same party and other party.
- vi) As per new provision, each side shall be entitled to operate a maximum of 7 frequencies per week in each direction on the routes specified in the Route Schedule.
- vii) Apart from the above, the new ASA also has the provisions relating to Revocation or Suspension of Operating Authorization, Principles governing operations of agreed services, Routing Flexibility, Commercial Opportunities, Aviation safety, Aviation security related clause etc. in the line of Indian model ASA.

POTENTIALITIES FOR MINING INVESTMENT IN TOGO

MINERAL SUBSTANCES WHICH MIGHT BE PROMOTED FOR MINING INVESTMENT IN TOGO

The efforts of the Togolese government, with the support of its main technical and financial partners have resulted to date in the provision of a considerable amount of knowledge to potential economic operators of the mining sector. Indeed, Togo has enormous mineral potential in terms of piece of which some were given extensive investigation that allowed their quantification. Others are in the process of elucidation by new research permits granted companies.

The regulatory framework of the mining sector consists of two laws on the Mining Code of the Republic of Togo, notably the law 96-004 on February 26, 1996 and the law 2003-012 on October 04, 2003 amending and completing the first one. These laws have become irrelevant; reason why the Ministry has requested and obtained from the investment and equipment budget a fund for the development of a national mining policy document with its action plan and the reading of the mining code with development of its implementing legislation. The process is ongoing with the assistance of the firm De Gaulle Fleurance & Associes in Paris.

Potential for exploitation

I- Metalliferous resources

1- Iron

The iron deposit is located in the prefecture of Bassar. It is deposit scattered in many localities which in fact, extends to Ghana, Where it forms the Shieni deposit. The reserves are estimated at 500 million tons with an average grade of 45%; this is the hematite iron. This deposit is currently operated by the company MM Mining S.A under the large-scale exploitation license granted in 2008 on the Buem (3,708 Km²) and Atacora (11.621 Km²) under the terms of the exclusive agreement signed on August 7, 2006.

2- Manganese of Nayega

The manganese deposit is located about 670 km from Lome, at Nayega in the prefecture of Kpendjal. Mineralization take the form of more or less lateritic black blocks. The manganese grade ranges from 10-35%. The deposit, estimated at about 13 million tonnes is part of the deposits granted in MM Mining Convention. However, it is subject to application of large-scale operating license by a Togolese branch (SGM) of the Australian mining company(Ferrex).

3-Chromite

Chromite is present in the facies of the ultrabasic basic furrow. The main quantified deposits are those of Haito Mountains located about 145 km from Lome of a grading of 34 to 38% Cr metal with reserves estimated at 20,000 tonnes and those of Ferende located at 450 km from Lome as 22.1 to 28.9% Cr₂O₃ with reserves of 30,000 tons. These deposits are poorly known. However, they are part of the deposits under agreement with MM Mining Convention.

4- Bauxite

Bauxite is the ore from which aluminium is extracted. The Mount Agou deposit has modest reserves (1 million tonnes); which make it uneconomical. It may be used locally for the production of refractory bricks. This deposit also is part of the deposits under the agreement with the MM Mining Convention

5-Nickel

It is displayed in Haito Mountains; reserves are estimated at 16 million cubic meters with a grade of 0.7% Ni metal.

II-Non-metalliferous resources

6- Phosphates

Phosphates are found in the Eocene age formations of the coastal sedimentary basin (soft in exploitation by SNPT and carbonated) and in meta-sedimentary formations of the upper Proterozoic in the Bassar region. Reserves are estimated at:

- Soft Phosphate: still 70 million tonnes at 36% P₂O₅;
- Carbonated Phosphate: more than 2000 million tonnes at 20% P₂O₅;
- Metaphospharenite: reserves 300 million tonnes at 20-36% P₂O₅;

7- Limestone

Identified deposits are found in the coastal basin: outside Tabligbo in exploitation including Aveta in Zio (200 million tonnes), Kpome (Zio) and Animabio in the Vo. The limestone of Aveta is penalized by the presence of phosphorus which make it at present stage of knowledge, not conducive to manufacture of cement.

8- Peat

It has been demonstrated in Tabligbo region, as well as in the systems of Togo and Boko lakes. The reserves are estimated at 5 million cubic meters. It is a fossil substance often use as a source of energy in industry, domestic and agriculture for soil amendment.

9- Garnet

Identified in the plateaux region in the north of Atakpame, it is of good quality for its use in jewelry. The reserves are 100,000 tonnes.

10- The marble stones

The marble stones of Togo consist of: impure marble (crystalline dolomite) and limestone. According to tests carried out on most listed sites (Gnaoulou, Djeti, Kamina East0Mono, Pagala, Namon, Djamde ... etc.), these stone are suitable for wall cladding flooring in building construction. The reserves are substantial. Deposits of Gnaoulou and that better known of Pagala contain over 800 million tonnes; formerly exploited by SOTOMA, the Pagala deposit is assigned to a company called POMAR Togo, a subsidiary of a Spanish company which then signed an agreement with the state for its development.

11- Ornamental stones

These are the granites, migmatites, gneiss, diorite and quartzite which constitute the backbone of these stones. The reserves are substantial.

12- Bentonite and attapulgites clays

They are found in the coastal basin of Aveta, at Watchidome (75 km from Lome). The reserves are 20 million for attapulgite clays and 300 million for bentonite clays.

13- The Kaolin clays

Kaolin clays are mainly observed at Afagnangan, at Nyitoe-Zoukpe in Kplaine and Houloum in the north of Kara. Known reserves are 1.5 to 125 million tonnes. They are mainly used in ceramics (tiles, pottery ... etc.).

This directory, not exhaustive, will be expanded to other potentially as fast as ongoing research will provide more detail.

Potential for research

1- Platinum of Soto Mountains

The Platinoid anomalies (Pt, Pd) were identified in the Kabye massifs on Soto Mountains by teams of the office of Mining and Geological Research (BRGM) of France and the General Directorate of Mines and Geology (DGMG) during generally mapping campaign in 1991.

Subsequently, UNDP project TOG 99/B05 continued work for more research mainly oriented on the Platinum and Palladium. And an abnormal area that stretches about 2km long and 500 m wide with a Pt grade well above 40 ppb has been circumscribed.

This area can interest potential mining investors whose work would lead without fail to discover major deposits.

2- Tha Klabe/ Azafi Diamond (Plateaux Akposso –Akebou)

Diamond stones are collected regularly in the alluvial beds of the Wawa River and its tributaries on the Akposso-Akebou Plateau near Klabe-Azafi. To date, their origin remains unknown but already more than 5,000 stones were harvested by miners and diamineurs.

3- Polymetals (Zn-Pb-As-Ba-Cu-Fe-Ni)

Polymetallic anomalies were found in several places of the country: Akposso-Akebou plateaux (Katora zone), Agbandiarea (Blitta). hills area (Kante) etc. These anomalies deserve appropriate works that will allow identifying mineable deposits. However, some of these sites are subject to research permits by mining companies known internationally.

4- The gold throughout the country

Early work has catalogued nearly 150 gold sites throughout the territory, But if so far the works of roughing have not allowed to discover a mineable deposit, it is hoped for the presence of small deposits that may be the subject of artisanal mining (case of Aleheride-kemeni area in Tchaoudjo).

5- The Corundum

This mineral was discovered along the Djabatoure-Soutouboua massifs. The deposit is not well known. Given the size and quality of these stones, the subject merits further study

Research Projects in Progress:

- The exploration licenses for uranium (U) have been granted in several locality in which the most promising are those of Niamtougou (Doufelgou) and Kara (Kozah);
- Zinc(Zn) is also under investigation in Pagala (Blitta);
- The ilmenite (TiO₂) investigated by the research projects of DGMG at Bagbe (Ave); a research permit is held by Global Merchants in the area;
- Monazite (P₂O₅ + cesium + lanthanum + thorium +/- other are soils) in Bassan Kope (East-Mono)

Conclusion:

The deposits that can be industrially exploited at the stage of recent investigations: marbles and ornamental stones, industrial clays, dolomites and limestone (for example that of Aveta). The majority of deposits still require more extensive work with modern methods of investigation of better quantify reserves as, those we classify unusable today can be tomorrow with the new methods
